Fees (no refund for scratched classes)

- \$6.00/class fee horse/rider combination
- \$15.00/jackpot class fee horse/rider combination
- \$5.00/office fee horse/rider combination (per show)
- \$5.00/high point fee horse/rider combination (per show)

Exhibition barrels (run during lunch break)

- \$5.00/2 runs – pay at the gate

Divisions (age as of January 1)

- Walk/Trot: any age rider; horse/rider combination is restricted to Walk/Trot division only (per show)
- Tiny Tot: age 10 and under
- Intermediate: age 11-18
- Senior: age 19+

Awards

- Walk/Trot & Tiny Tot: choice of food stand voucher or ribbon for 1st – 6th place (pick up after the class)
- Intermediate/Senior: payback 1st – 3rd place
- Jackpot: payback 1st – 3rd place
- High Point & Reserve High Point for each division at each show – must be MSC member to qualify

More

- All horses on grounds must show proof of current-year negative Coggins, and a copy to leave with the office
- Helmets required for riders under 18, recommended for all others; boots required
- Appropriate tack is required
- Stallions must be handled by a person 19+
- All dogs must be on a leash
- No camping/no stalls on grounds
- Lunch stand on grounds
- Year-end awards and banquet for MSC members – Memberships must be completed the day of the show to qualify for high points and year-end awards; Memberships start at \$20.00
